

## Weston County Sportsmans Club Range Rules

**NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE RANGE.** The firing range is on city property and as such it falls under city ordinance which forbids open containers. Any member shooting at the range while under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs shall be suspended from the club for life.

**FIREARM DISCHARGE.** The discharge of firearms will only be done down range at standard targets. Absolutley no bottles, can, etc. other than down range at standard targets will be suspended from the club.

**SECURITY.** Gates will be kept closed and locked at all times.

**FIREARM SAFETY.** All firearms will be unloaded, with the action open when not being used on the firing line.

**SHOOTING HOURS.** Shooting is allowed from 1/2 hour before sun up to 1/2 hour after sun set. **Note:** this is the same as normal hunting hours.

**PETS.** Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.

**LIABILITY.** The Weston County Sportsman's Club will not be held responsible for any accidents.

**VEHICLE PARKING.** All motorized vehicles shall be kept is designated parking areas only.

**CLEAN-UP.** Range users will be responsible for range conditions and will properly dispose of all litter, used targets, spent cartridges, etc. before leaving the range.

**GUEST'S ACTIONS.** Range users are responsible for the actions of their guests (including children) and must be accompanied by a club member at all times.

**LOCK COMBINATION CONFIDENTIALITY.** Club members will not loan the lock combination to anyone at any time.

**GUEST FEES.** Range users will be responsible for turning their guests fees into the club treasurer. The fees are \$5.00 per day. This includes all family members over the age of 18.

**FAMILY MEMBERSHIP.** A family membership includes all dependant children age 18 or younger or disables children living at home.

**TRESPASS LAW VIOLATIONS.** Anyone using the range other than club members and their guests will be subject to trespass law violations.
